
This program works

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following criteria to participate:

1. Women entrepreneurs who:

- ▶ Owners/founders/co-founders/CEOs with a substantial ownership of the business
- ▶ Demonstrate passion to grow their business and scale up internationally

2. Businesses that:

- ▶ Are at least 2 years old
- ▶ Have annual revenues higher than EUR 1 million

3. Applicants who are selected must be able to attend and fully participate in:

- ▶ Three day (3-4 hours each day) virtual Orientation Conference in October 2021, dates TBC.
- ▶ Monthly one-hour virtual sessions during the period November 2021 to June 2022.

Those unable to commit to the required participation in 2021/22 should instead consider applying for future classes, when schedules will permit attendance.

Note: The conferences and all sessions will be delivered in English.
