Argentina

Argentina relaxes COVID-19-related entry requirements

Executive summary

Inbound travelers to Argentina are no longer subject to COVID-19 testing or quarantine requirements, irrespective of their COVID-19 vaccination status. Individuals arriving from Ukraine may be exempt from certain COVID-19-related requirements.

Background

Travelers are considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 for purposes of entry into Argentina if they received all required (non-booster) doses of a COVID-19 vaccine (e.g., two doses of Pfizer-BioNTech) at least 14 days prior to travel.

Key issues

Effective 7 April 2022, citizens and residents of Argentina who are not fully vaccinated against COVID-19 are no longer required to get tested for COVID-19 prior to travel or after arrival in Argentina. They are also no longer required to quarantine for seven days on arrival.

Partially vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals who are not citizens or residents of Argentina are similarly exempt from COVID-19 testing and quarantine requirements if they enter Argentina from a bordering country (i.e., Brazil, Bolivia, Chile, Paraguay, Uruguay).

Individuals who are not citizens or residents of Argentina and are traveling to Argentina from a location other than a bordering country are no longer required to get tested for COVID-19 prior to travel or upon arrival, or to quarantine upon arrival in Argentina, irrespective of their COVID-19 vaccination status.

All inbound travelers are still subject to random COVID-19 testing on arrival, and those who test positive may be required to undergo further COVID-19 testing and/or quarantine after entry. All inbound travelers are also still required to hold health insurance that covers the costs of COVID-19-related medical treatment while in Argentina and complete an [online health declaration](#) no more than 48 hours prior to travel.

Ukrainian citizens

Individuals traveling to Argentina from Ukraine, including Ukrainian citizens and non-citizens, are not required to hold health insurance that covers the cost of COVID-19-related health services, provided they remain in Argentina for more than 90 days and apply for temporary residence. These individuals will be eligible to access Argentina's public health system and receive necessary medical services, including those related to COVID-19. Travelers who arrive from Ukraine and stay in Argentina for 90 days or less are required to have health insurance that covers the costs of treatment related to COVID-19. All travelers arriving from Ukraine are still required to complete the online health declaration prior to travel.
