

## The Award Categories

From among these category winners will emerge the **EY Entrepreneur Of The Year 2024 Philippines** who will represent the country in the EY World Entrepreneur Of The Year in Monte Carlo, Monaco in 2025.

#### Master Entrepreneur

An individual who has maintained management excellence over a sustained period of time; the business must have been founded more than five years ago.

#### Woman Entrepreneur

An individual who has shown exemplary management excellence over a sustained period of time, making her a trailblazer in her particular field of business.

#### Small Business Entrepreneur

An individual engaged in industry and/or services whose total assets must not have a value exceeding PHP 100 million (excluding land).

#### Young Entrepreneur

An individual 35 years old or younger who has shown exemplary management excellence over a sustained period of time, making him or her an inspiration and a role model to the youth.

#### Technology Entrepreneur

An individual who has innovatively leveraged technology to transform and enhance the delivery of products and services to customers, grow the business and create a positive impact on their stakeholders and community.



## What is an entrepreneur?

Entrepreneurs include both founders of companies and those who organize, manage and assume the "educated" risks of a business or enterprise in the companies' life or development and are active in the leadership of the company.

- Traditionally, the entrepreneur is the CEO/ original founder of an organization.
- Entrepreneurs can also be CEOs that come on board to join an existing business.
- In select cases, the CEO/ President of a subsidiary of a Philippine company may also qualify as an entrepreneur.
- be multigenerational (i.e., business passed from generation to generation). The new leadership should exhibit their own form of risk management and also "make their mark" on the family business.
- Whether the original founder or a nonfounding CEO/ entrepreneur, these individuals find creative and venturesome ways to acquire the capital resources, build their team and innovate to achieve their goals and to build and grow their business. They create value for themselves, their employees, their customers and their communities.



## The nomination process


#### The nominee must be:

- A Filipino citizen
- An owner of a privately held business that is at least two years old
- Primarily responsible for the company's recent performance
- Still active in top-level management if he or she is the founder of a publicly-held company

## The nominee must submit:

- A completed nomination form
- The company's audited financial statements for 2021, 2022 and 2023
- Other supporting documents and essays


