

CONSENT TO PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA

A person that completes the form **Subscribe to our Editor's picks newsletter** on this website in order to receive newsletters from EY thereby gives Ernst & Young (CIS) B.V., Moscow branch (hereinafter, "EY"), registered at Sadovnicheskaya Naberezhnaya, 77, bld. 1, Moscow 115035, consent to process their personal data (hereinafter, "Personal Data") on the following terms:

1. This Consent is granted for processing Personal Data both with and without automated means.
2. This Consent is granted for processing the following Personal Data:
Personal Data that is not special or biometric: first and last names; place of work (organization) and position; contact details (email address).
3. The Personal Data is not deemed publicly available.
4. Purpose of Personal Data processing: to subscribe to, and receive, email newsletters from EY.
5. Basis for processing Personal Data: Article 24 of the Constitution of the Russian Federation; Article 6 of Federal Law No. 152-FZ "On Personal Data" of 27 July 2006; this Consent to Processing Personal Data.
6. Personal Data processing may involve the following procedures:
collection, recording, systematization, accumulation, storage, modification (updating, revision), retrieval, use, deletion, destruction, blocking, and transfer (dissemination, provision, access).
In addition, consent is hereby given for Personal Data to be processed by third parties for the purposes indicated in clause 4 of this Consent.
7. This Consent also covers the possible transfer of Personal Data to legal entities that are members of Ernst & Young Global as well as to third parties that provide services to members of Ernst & Young Global for the purposes indicated in clause 4 of this Consent.
8. This Consent also covers the cross-border transfer of Personal Data to legal entities that are members of Ernst & Young Global and operate in foreign states (Republic of Belarus).
9. The Personal Data will be processed at EY until the purpose of processing it is achieved or until written notice is received from the Personal Data owner withdrawing their Consent to processing their Personal Data. The Personal Data will be destroyed within no more than 12 calendar months thereafter.
10. This Consent may be withdrawn by sending a written notice to EY's Marketing Department at the address indicated in the introductory paragraph of this Consent.
11. If the Personal Data owner or their representative withdraws this Consent to Processing Personal Data, EY may continue processing such Personal Data without the Personal Data owner's consent on the grounds stipulated in Article 6, Part 1, clauses 2-11; Article 10, Part 2; and Article 11, Part 2, of Federal Law No. 152-FZ "On Personal Data" of 27 June 2006.
12. This Consent shall be valid until the processing of the Personal Data indicated in clauses 9 and 10 of this Consent is discontinued.
