Mexico takes first steps to ratify MLI

On 6 October 2022, the Mexican Senate's joint committee of the Ministries of Foreign Affairs and Treasury approved the *Multilateral Instrument to implement Tax Treaty Related Measures to Prevent Base Erosion and Profit Shifting (MLI)*, which Mexico signed on 7 June 2017. This approval leads the way for the vote by the full Senate needed for formal ratification and subsequent deposit with the OECD.

Peruvian Congress ratifies Convention to Harmonize Double Tax Treaties of Pacific Alliance

The Peruvian Congress on 5 October 2022 enacted Legislative Resolution 31580 ratifying the Convention to Harmonize the Double Tax Treaties of the Pacific Alliance countries.

Puerto Rico's Treasury Department issues guidance on the tax measures and extended due dates in place because of Hurricane Fiona

In Administrative Determination 22-08, the Puerto Rico Treasury Department issued guidance on the tax measures put in place as a result of the state of emergency declared by the Governor of Puerto Rico because of Hurricane Fiona. Specifically, the due date is extended to 15 December 2022 for individual, pass-through entities, and corporate income tax returns.

Colombia extends due date to submit initial ultimate beneficial owners' information

Under Resolution 1240 of 28 September 2022, the Colombian tax authority extended the due date for submitting the initial information on ultimate beneficial owners to 31 July 2023, for all legal entities and structures without legal status created before 31 May 2023.

Ecuadorian tax authority reforms definitions and tax treatment for tax havens, minor tax jurisdictions and special tax regimes

The Ecuadorian Internal Revenue Service modified the list of regimes and jurisdictions considered tax havens. Additionally, the IRS eliminated the concepts of minor tax jurisdiction and special tax regime.

OECD publishes Manual on Bilateral APAs

On 28 September 2022, the OECD published its <u>Bilateral Advance Pricing Arrangement Manual</u> as part of the ongoing tax certainty work of the OECD's Forum on Tax Administration. The Manual is intended to provide an effective guide on Bilateral Advance Pricing Agreements (BAPAs) for both tax administrations and taxpayers, setting out the objectives of BAPAs and obstacles currently faced.



USCIS extends Green Card validity extension to 24 months for Green Card renewals

Effective 26 September 2022, US Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) will automatically extend the validity of Permanent Resident Cards (commonly known as Green Cards) to 24 months for applicants who file Form I-90, Application to Replace Permanent Resident Card, to renew an expiring or expired Green Card.
