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G20 Finance Ministers reiterate commitment to BEPS 2.0 two-pillar implementation and call for action to finalize work

On 15-16 July 2022, the G20 Ministers of Finance and Governors of Central Banks met in Bali, Indonesia. The G20 Chair's <u>summary</u> issued at the conclusion of the meeting includes a reiteration of the G20 Finance Ministers' ongoing commitment to implement the agreement on the G20/OECD BEPS 2.0 two-pillar international tax package. The summary includes a call for action to finalize Pillar One, including by signing the Multilateral Convention in the first half of 2023, and

to complete the negotiations that would allow the development of the Multilateral Instrument for implementation of the Subject to Tax Rule under Pillar Two.

Brazilian Federal Revenue Service and the Inter-American Development Bank hold seminar as part of process to present new Brazilian transfer pricing system

The Brazilian Federal Revenue Service (RFB) and the Inter-American Development Bank held a transfer pricing (TP) seminar to discuss in detail various topics related to the new Brazilian TP system proposal, which would implement the arm's-length principle (ALP) in Brazil. During the seminar, the RFB shared the structure of the proposed law, presented details on the concept and implementation of the ALP for specific transactions, and confirmed some additional information and guidance that had been indicated in recent events and discussion groups in which the RFB had participated.

Honduras joins the Multilateral Convention on Mutual Administrative Assistance in Tax Matters

Honduras signed the Multilateral Convention on Mutual Administrative Assistance in Tax Matters with the OECD. The Convention will empower tax officials to exchange tax information with other jurisdictions that are party to the Convention.

Canada to resume mandatory random testing of fully vaccinated air travelers

The federal government announced that mandatory random COVID-19 testing for fully vaccinated air travelers will resume on 19 July 2022. Testing will be limited to international travelers arriving to Canada at four major airports: Vancouver, Calgary, Toronto, and Montreal, and the testing will happen offsite for arriving travelers and within terminal for transiting passengers.

USCIS to implement second phase of premium processing expansion for certain pending multinational manager/executive and national interest waiver petitions

On 15 July 2022, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) announced that it will implement the second phase of the premium processing expansion for certain previously filed I-140 petitions in the multinational manager and executive (EB-1C) as well as the EB-2 National Interest Waiver (NIW) categories. Beginning 1 August 2022, EB-1C petitions pending since 1 July 2021 (or earlier) and NIW petitions pending since 1 August 2021 (or earlier) will be eligible for an upgrade to premium processing.
