This learning journey is designed in collaboration between the EY Norway Family Enterprise Competence Center and the Strømme Foundation. This will showcase the different stages of the Foundation's Development Roadmap and give you an insight into some of the challenges faced by the poor in developing countries, and examples of successful interventions.

The journey will give you a thorough understanding of what sustainable development entails while offering insights into different cultures, ways of life, exceptional human encounters and inspiration on how to become agents of positive change - something that you might not experience during a regular vacation trip.

Together, we will visit the SAMVAD adolescent empowerment programme in Lumbini. This will give us a first-hand experience of a poor rural community, and of the adolescents' fight against various social ills such as child marriage. We will learn how the empowered youth are raising social awareness in their community, how they are raising their voices collectively to influence the local governments and to transform the society.

The learning journey is for next generation family members who want to learn together about the powerful role of philanthropy, impact, empowerment,

positive change and sustainable development. It is an opportunity for them to build a better working world and to show how families in business can also be a force for good in the society.

We will be staying in local hotels, all carefully selected to provide lasting impression of the beauty and hospitality of Nepal. You will be accompanied by senior staff from EY and Strømme Foundation.

In preparation of this trip, we will all meet up to get to know each other. We will then go through the program and start diving into the overall global challenges related to poverty and possible solutions.

We are keeping the number of seats to 10 in order to offer the best possible learning journey for everyone.

Tuesday 10: Adolescents as change agents

- ▶ Breakfast and introduction to the program of the day
- ▶ Return to SAMVAD and see how adolescents are raising social awareness in the community by educating their parents and siblings
- ▶ Continued sessions with SAMVAD participants: Learn how they use their voices to transform society and influence the local government
- ▶ Dinner, learning reflections and debrief

Wednesday 11: From social to economic empowerment

- ▶ Breakfast and introduction to the program of the day
- ▶ Field visit to discover how women have organized self-help groups to improve their social and economic conditions through collective activity
- ▶ Cultural visit (optional): Buddha's birthplace
- ▶ Dinner, learning reflections and debrief
